Walkway project fundraiser

The FAUCSC site regularly receives visitors, making public safety and accessibility a key priority. **We are currently fundraising toward a goal of \$3,000 to build a walkway and handrails at the site.**

State grants enable improvements

FAUCSC secured several grants from PA Preservation and PA Hallowed Grounds that funded the removal of dead trees from the site, and the purchase of landscaping and gravestone cleaning equipment for ongoing site maintenance. An acknowledgment plaque has been installed in the information kiosk at the site.

National Registry of Historic Places eligibility

FAUCSC was deemed eligible by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Historic Preservation for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and has begun the application process for this important recognition.
